### FUJI pendant lamp

*FUJI, named after the Japanese mountain, is a reimagination of the traditional circular shape of the paper lantern, crafting an equilateral octagon solely through the use of heat treatment, without relying on any wire structure.*

**Material:** Shade made of washi paper treated with stain-preventing coating, cast in PET resin without a wire structure. HIBA wood cone-shaped top, natural oil.

**Number of light sources:** 1

**Max. power consumption:** 7W LED (60W)

**Cord:** White textile cord of 300 cm

**Canopy:** White made of polypropylene, D: 120 mm, H: 70 mm
