TAMA pendant lamp

TAMA means 'jewel' in Japanese and is a reimagination of the traditional circular shape of the paper lantern, crafting an equilateral octagon solely through the use of heat treatment, without relying on any wire structure.

Material: Shade made of washi paper treated with stain-preventing coating, cast in PET resin without a wire structure. HIBA wood cone-shaped top, natural oil

Max. power consumption: 7W LED (60W)

Cord: White textile cord of 300 cm

Canopy: White made of polypropylene, D: 120 mm, H: 70 mm
